MOVING FROM CANADA to Texas would be a big deal to most people, but for Costco member Fiona Green it felt like a short hop. "It was still a huge change, but I'd already moved over [4,800 kilometres] from Edinburgh [Scotland] to Montreal, so the [2,900 kilometres] to Keller was like a day trip," laughs Green.
